The driveway within the area of the public right-of-way shall slope away from the public road at a minimum of 1% and a maximum of 5% to prevent erosion onto the public road. An adequate roadbed of suitable material to support the projected traffic and any requirements for culverts shall be determined by the town board in considering an application for driveway approval. If metal culverts are required the recommended minimum diameter shall be 15". At the dead end of the driveway, a turn around of a least 25 ft radius or some other method to allow vehicles to turn around should be provided.	
An inspection fee (see current fee schedule) is required to be submitted with all applications for a driveway. The fee will be refunded if the location for a driveway is denied. If second inspection is not up to code a new application must be submitted and new fee will be charged. All driveways shall be constructed in accordance with the above requirements and the Town Board may set other specifications. The maintenance of the driveway shall be the responsibility of the applicant and/or property owner.
